Worship

Worship can take many forms. At Woolston, we have traditional services, quieter midweek group gatherings and Scout Parade Services in our Hall. Most Sundays we gather in our Chapel to praise God and listen to His holy word.

Sundays

Our Sunday services begin at 10.30 a.m. and last about an hour. These are joyous gatherings full of prayer and singing. The services are mainly of the traditional type, with something a bit different from time to time.

What happens on a Sunday?

Our worship is led by our minister or by local preachers from around the Southampton Circuit. Members of the congregation also lead occasionally. Our services aim to be accessible and meaningful for all and give an opportunity to praise God in a comfortable, friendly, and relaxed atmosphere. A collection plate is placed at the rear of the Chapel for donations to the work of our Church.

After every service, there is an opportunity for a hot drink, a chocolate biscuit, and a chat with new friends and old.

Holy Communion

The sacrament of Holy Communion is celebrated on the second Sunday of most months during the morning service.

Come Together

Come Together is a smaller group, gathering to pray, listen to Bible passages and to worship a little more intimately. The meeting is held in the Fellowship Room on the second Monday of every month from 7.30 p.m.

Room Hire

At Woolston we have a variety of different sized rooms available for hire, from a large hall with stage and balcony to a smaller meeting room.

The first is the Games Room. It can be used for group meetings, youth work or for some sports. It is perfect for children's parties and will easily accommodate a bouncy castle. It has a high ceiling and gas heating.

The second is our Main Hall. This can be used for larger gatherings or even staged productions. There is a balcony with seating for 70 and the main area can seat 120 comfortably.

The final room is our Fellowship Room. A smaller meeting room which can seat around 30 or can be used for smaller gatherings.

All our rooms come with use of chairs and tables included. There is also a fully equipped kitchen which is included in the hourly rate for the rooms.

As with all Methodist buildings, alcohol and gambling are not allowed on the premises.

The Dalian Players is an amateur dramatics group that have been meeting and performing at Woolston since 1952! Originally a Church group it has grown into a


modern amateur group performing plays and pantomimes, along with hosting entertainment filled Afternoon Teas and Christmas Banquets, all in our Main Hall.
